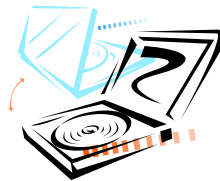

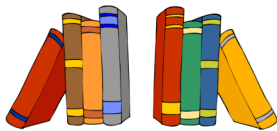

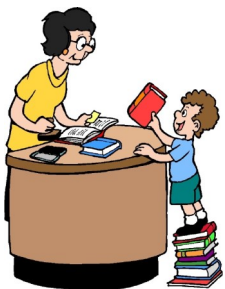

The Wringer Washer

As Mother's Day has come and gone this month, I thought about what mothers did to get ready, and to wash clothes. Time period 40's-50's.

You would have a washing machine, a set of double tubs, the tubs were to rinse the clothes from the washer a couple times to get the soap out.

Most times the water was bucketed from the sink to the washer, and the tubs.

It was jobs like these that kept our women in shape, so they did not have to read about calories and what was printed on our food stuff from the grocery store.

You laid out your washing piles; whites, colored and work clothes last. Now mind you, they used the same wash water just like your Saturday night bath.

As a very young boy I remember the fascination with the wringer. I loved to run the clothes through it maybe 3 or 4 times. It had 2 rolls that squeezed the water out of the clothes. It had a safety bar on the wringer that was painted red, I figured out how that worked. I wanted to be safety conscious in case I got my hand started in the rolls. You had to be safety conscious, sometimes mom never knew how many time you ran the clothes through. I remember them saying dad had to do the washing for some reason, and he had 7 or 8 bibbed overalls in the washer and the belt was slipping so he got some belt dressing at the barn. Not guessing maybe that it was too big of a load.

One other step in the wash day process you carried the wet clothes to the clothesline and then hung them up, and when they dried you had to bring them in. No 2 mile run needed for these girls.

During this time period I'm sure the women thought the wringer washer was a God send from anything previous.

To finish up why was Monday always considered Wash Day?

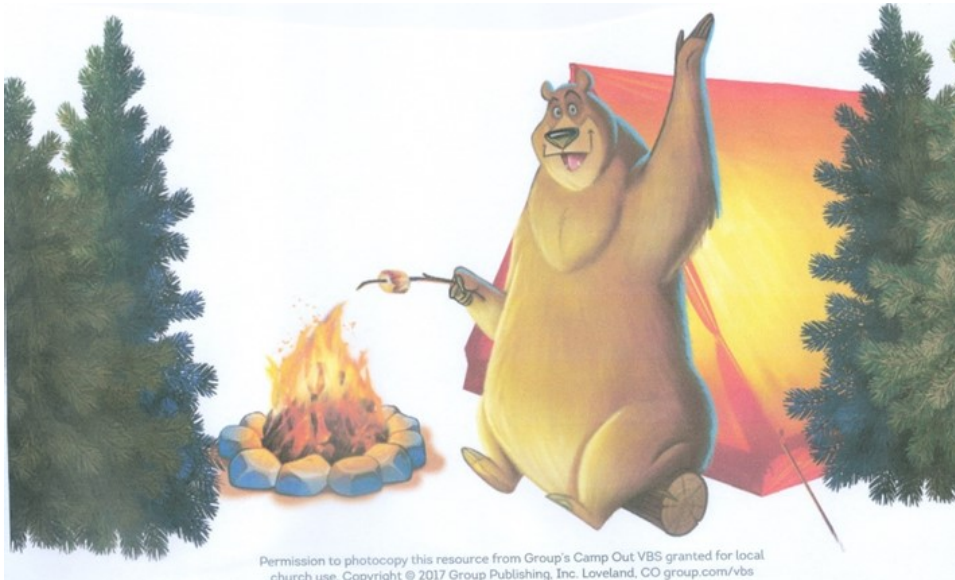

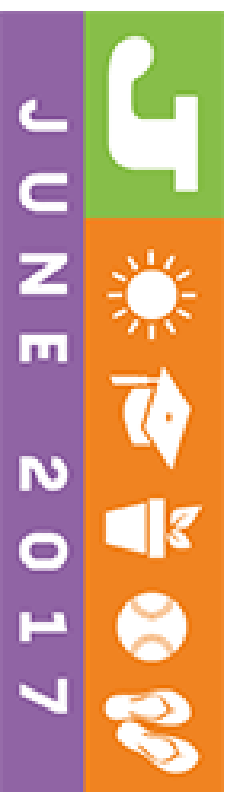


Open House
