Ford's Winter Home

Henry Ford and Thomas Edison were 16 years apart in age. Ford idolized his friend. The famous friendship between Henry Ford and Thomas Edison had its origin in their shared interest in innovative design but truly solidified around the time of WWI. In 1911, New York entrepreneur Robert Smith built a craftsman bungalow on the property adjacent to Thomas Edison Fort Myers Estate. At the same time, Ford and Edison were corresponding by mail, and in 1914 they took a fateful company trip together. Robert Smith noted that Henry Ford lodged at Thomas Edison's guest house and wrote the famous automobile magnate, inquiring if he would like to purchase the estate. Ford, who by this time had become a self made millionaire, purchased the home in 1916, becoming the neighbor of his friend and mentor.

The following year, Ford began an annual tradition that he would continue until Edison's death in 1931, visiting Fort Myers to help his famous friend and mentor celebrate his birthday. The time that Ford and Edison spent together in Fort Myers helped to strengthen their relationship and bring two of the worlds greatest innovators close together.

Unlike Edison, who often enjoyed talking with the media, Ford disliked the paparazzi and relished the peace Florida offered. Ford would even disembark from the train a mile outside of Fort Myers so that he could avoid the crowd of well– wishers at the train station.

After Edison's death Henry Ford never returned to his winter home in Fort Myers. I picked up this quote book of Edison and Ford and one quote I like was:

"Quality means doing it right, when no one is looking."

Make these hands as a helpful prayer guide.




What you need:

- Stickers


What you do:
