A Sister's Aid was organized on March 4, 1909. In 1913 the name of the organization was changed to the Dorcas Aid Society. The main purpose of this group was to sew for the needs of the community, mainly the Mexico Old Folks Home and Orphans Home. They made articles of clothing for the home and comforts, and mending when needed.

In 1963 the name of the organization was changed to the Women's Fellowship. The group continues to sew for community needs such as comforts for fire victims, nursing homes, Red Cross and mission projects. We also make wheel chair bags, walker bags and school bags for mission projects.

Women's Fellowship meets on the 2nd and 4th Wednesday of each month from 9:30 to 2:30. We enjoy a sack lunch each meeting and every quarter we share a carry-in Birthday Dinner (March, June, September, December). Come and join the group, we welcome guests.
